Community News and Events

An Update from Share Hope

Prince George Share Hope Refugee Support Society has been very busy over the last two years helping bring and settle Ukrainians fleeing the war in Ukraine.

To date our community has received inquiries to settle at least 510 displaced Ukrainians from almost 200 families. As of today, we have helped to settle 315 of these displaced Ukrainians within Prince George and a further 38 across our region.

May 9, 2022: "Building the Future with Migrants and Refugees" was the theme chosen by the Holy Father for the 108th World Day of Migrants and Refugees (WDMR). Pope Francis highlighted the commitment that we are all called to share in building a future that embraces God's plan, leaving no one behind.

The theme of Pope Francis's Message for the World Day of Migrants and Refugees 2024 was: "God walks with his people."

Share Hope has delivered on Pope Francis' guidance and directions. Not only have we found affordable housing for displaced Ukrainians, but we have furnished homes for them, thanks to the generosity of the people of Prince George. Our volunteers have assisted them in their required documentation, applications for government funding, applying for their SIN numbers, drivers' licenses, opening bank accounts, registering children for school, learning English, finding jobs, attending doctor's appointments, getting glasses, support for some extra curricular activities and much more.



We have befriended them, and we have learned a lot from them too. The Ukrainians who have come here are very grateful and want to give back. Many of them want to stay here and make Prince George their permanent home.

You can see in the attached photo taken at Camp Morice that we are all one – we are God's people enjoying life in Canada where we are safe.
