On February 25, 2025, His Holiness Pope Francis accepted the resignation of the Most Reverend J. Michael Miller, C.SB. as the Archbishop of Vancouver and appointed the Most Reverend Richard Smith, presently Archbishop of Edmonton, as his successor.
