Jubilee News from Prince Rupert

Family Day, Feb. 17, 2025 (Annunciation Parish)

Mass was celebrated at 9:00 am with over 50 parishioners in attendance. Around 30+ walked down to the old train station now a pub, praying the rosary. From there we walked to Cow Bay and enjoyed coffee together. It was a blast! The weather was perfect, a bit cold but full sunshine made the walk a delightful experience.

At the Mass we sang the Jubilee song and Fr. Terry explained the Jubilee poster and the meaning of the Jubilee year. We used a special Eucharistic prayer, <u>God guides His Church along the Way of Salvation</u>, and after the Mass prayed the rosary as we walked through the city streets (that were mostly empty due to the holiday nature.) 


about, saw a nice group of devoted Catholics praying, smiling and happy.

Chrism Mass - April 9, 2025

Clergy, religious and lay faithful from across the diocese will gather with Bishop Stephen Jensen for the annual Chrism Mass at 7:00 P.M. Wednesday, April 9, 2025, at Sacred Heart Cathedral. The Chrism Mass will be followed by reception. Those attending are invited to bring a plate of snacks to share and are asked to put the snack on the designated table in the lower hall before Mass.



Everyone is welcome to join our diocesan community for this important celebration. During the Chrism Mass, the priests of the diocese renew their commitment to priestly ministry. The Oil of the Sick, Oil of the

Catechumens, and Sacred Chrism for use in the celebration of sacraments throughout the year are also blessed and consecrated by Bishop Stephen Jensen during the annual Chrism Mass.

CCCB and Petitions

CCCB Sends Letters to the Hon. Pierre Poilievre and Hon. Mark Holland Regarding Charitable Status and MAiD

On March 10, 2025, the CCCB sent two letters to the federal government. The first, addressed to the Hon. Pierre Poilievre, Conservative Party Leader and Leader of the Official Opposition, was regarding concerns about proposals made by the federal Standing Committee on Finance to change eligibility criteria for charitable status. Such changes would make it so that organizations which support the advancement of religion or pro-life initiatives will no longer be eligible for charitable status.

The second letter, addressed to the Hon. Mark Holland, Minister of Health, was regarding a recently-concluded "national consultation" on expanding Medical Assistance in Dying (MAiD) in view of introducing advance requests.


Lenten Reconciliation at Our Lady of the Snows, Fort St. James


